
The meeting will begin with committee member updates on upcoming activities and events. Updates will include a discussion of recent Notices of Funding Opportunities issued by Adult Redeploy Illinois and VAWA multidisciplinary teams, along with other ICJIA grant opportunities of relevance to local coordinating groups.

Next, we will have a discussion on using data for criminal justice planning projects in local coordinating groups. This will focus on dashboard development for county stakeholders and how to access more timely state and local data through ICJIA or other agencies.
